SAG-AFTRA reported 1192 members who were employed on local productions for 2021:

- 257 members who were employed in 51 commercials
- 29 members recording 16 corporate educational videos
- 50 members in 7 video games
- 856 members booked on 53 TV, theatrical or new media productions

SAG-AFTRA reported members who were employed on local productions for 2022 to date:

- 209 members working on 24 commercials
- 9 members on 8 corporate educational videos
- 21 members in 4 video games
- 570 members booked on 20 TV, theatrical or new media agreements
